

Personalized Mentorship Program

Personalized, Supervised, Surgical, and Prosthetic Treatment on Your Own Patient

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course provides experienced dentists with the opportunity to increase their surgical skills and repertoire by treating their own patient(s) with personalized supervision and guidance by Dr. Norman W. Ickert.

The course begins with each participant's case presentation, followed by a discussion of your case, and the cases of the three other course participants'. Valuable surgical and prosthetic principles will be highlighted for each case. The treatment planning discussion will be followed by five hours of operatory time devoted to you and the management of your patient's treatment.

The day concludes with a detailed discussion of each case, including photographic documentation of your surgery, which will be distributed to each participant.

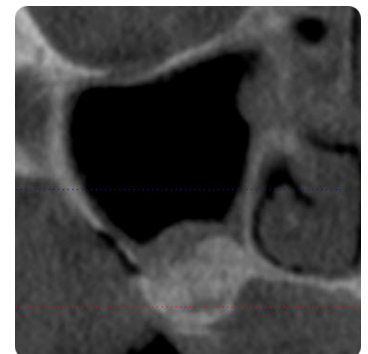
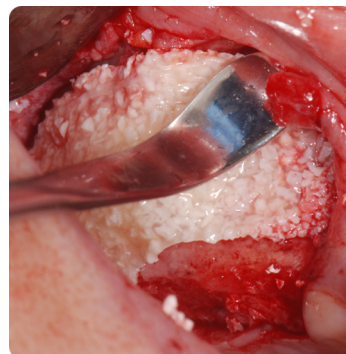
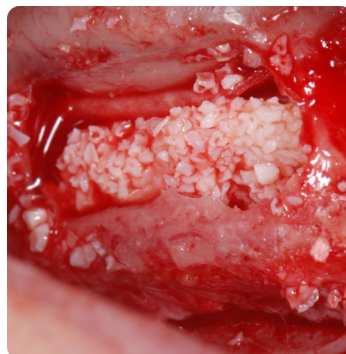
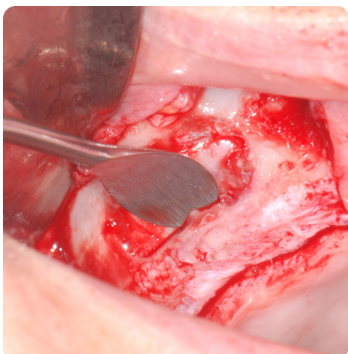

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of the Personalized Mentorship Program, you will have been exposed to

- five hours of supervised and personalized surgical time with your own patient(s)
- three hours of didactic information, case presentations, and treatment planning for each participant's patient(s)
- a personalized mentorship experience for both yourself, and your clinical partner(s)
- course documentation including surgical photographs and a pre and post-operative CT scan of your patient(s)
- a comprehensive implant training course that will allow you to implement the use of your desired implant system during your patient's surgery.



RECOMMENDED PROCEDURES

Learn and master new procedures in a safe and supportive environment:

- Bone block grafts
- Guided bone regeneration
- Sinus elevations with or without simultaneous implant placement
- Ridge split bone grafting
- Alloderm soft tissue grafting
- Subepithelial connective tissue grafting
- Free gingival grafts
- Roll flaps to increase soft tissue volume
- Palatal rotation flaps
- Apically repositioned flaps
- Kazanjianplasty flaps

Dr. Norman W. Ickert completed his general dental education at Vancouver's University of British Columbia in 1982. He is the Director of the Ickert Dental Implant Centre, a referral practice limited to implant related dentistry, as well the Director of the Ickert Teaching Centre, an educational centre for hands on training in implant dentistry.

Dr. Ickert is a Mentor, a Clinical Instructor, and a former Advisory Board Member at Seattle, Washington's Kois Center. He has his IPS Mastership Certificate from the International Congress of Oral Implantologists and is a member of the Academy of Osseointegration. He is currently enrolled in the International Medical College's Master's Program in Implantology, University of Muenster, Germany, graduating in October of 2011.
