## **PERSONALIZED MENTORSHIP PROGRAM**

*One Day Course - Maximum of 4 participants per session*

This course provides experienced dentists with the opportunity to increase their surgical skills and repertoire by treating their own patient(s) with personalized supervision and guidance by Dr. Norman W. Ickert.

The course begins with each participant's case presentation, followed by a discussion of your case, and the cases of the three other course participants'. Valuable surgical and prosthetic principles will be highlighted for each case. The treatment planning discussion will be followed by five hours of operatory time devoted to you and the management of your patient's treatment.

The day concludes with a detailed discussion of each case, including photographic documentation of your surgery, which will be distributed to each participant.

This course is specifically designed for graduates of at least one course at the Ickert Teaching Centre, and focuses on treatment planning, followed by surgical and prosthetic treatment performed on your selected patient.

### **Procedures:**

Learn and master new procedures in a safe and supportive environment:

- Bone block grafts
- Guided bone regeneration
- Sinus elevations with or without simultaneous implant placement
- Ridge split bone grafting
- Alloderm soft tissue grafting
- Subepithelial connective tissue grafting
- Free gingival grafts
- Roll flaps to increase soft tissue volume
- Palatal rotation flaps
- Apically repositioned flaps
- Kazanjianplasty flaps

## Benefits:

At the conclusion of each course, you will have been exposed to

- five hours of supervised and personalized surgical time with your patient
- three hours of didactic information, case presentations, and treatment planning for each participant's patient
- a personalized mentorship experience for both yourself, and your clinical partner(s)
- course documentation including surgical photographs and a pre and post operative CT scan of your patient
- a comprehensive implant training course that will allow you to implement the use of your desired implant system during your patient's surgery.

## Notes:

- Valid licensing and insurance in BC is required to operate at the Ickert Teaching Centre. This is available at a very reasonable fee of approximately \$200. We will gladly assist you with the process of obtaining it.
- Course tuition includes one Clinical Partner (staff member). The fee for each additional staff member is \$200.00.
- The cost of any implants, related materials, and supplies is additional.
- Many of our suppliers will provide participants with complimentary implants, selected on a case by case basis. Please contact us for additional information and details.
- Operating on multiple patients is acceptable during your operatory time.
- Dr. Ickert requires each participant's treatment plan and case information be sent to him a minimum of two weeks prior to the course date. This will give him the opportunity to evaluate the suitability of your selected case.
